## Dunchurch Youth Club Re-awakes

The Parish Council have entered into a partnership with *Realize Network* to re-establish a youth club for Dunchurch's young people. *Realize Network (R-N)* is a non-profit organisation providing affordable well-organised, professionally delivered services for the benefit of young people and the wider community. The PC have been awarded a grant of £10,000 from Rugby Borough's Rural Development Fund which will be matched from the PC's reserves to allow this exciting project to go ahead.

R-N is already leading Youth Clubs in our neighbouring, Northamptonshire Parishes of Kilsby and Barby & Onley where their efforts have been highly praised.

Government will in future be requiring local authorities to provide active support for their young people; so Dunchurch is going to be ahead of the game with a strategy tailored for its needs, and a service delivered locally- not remotely as in the past.

Our advert shows the initial offerings which we hope to develop according to demand and the wishes of the young people themselves. This will not be the stereotypical youth club but a highly structured and supervised one, with personal development a major part of Realize Network's philosophy.

Involvement of parents and other members of our community will also be sought as an integral part of the structure. J Sainsbury PLC is also to become involved encouraging our initial efforts with a contribution that will allow provision of healthy food snacks at club meetings.

Although starting with little in the way of equipment the club hopes to acquire items to extend the activities on offer at club meetings.
